My hope is that this process keeps us engaged, united, and committed to building vibrant faith communities.

By embracing transparency, accountability, and compliance, we can meet the challenges ahead with confidence and hope. 'So stay awake, because you do not know the day when your master is coming. You may be quite sure of this that if the householder had known at what time of the night the burglar would come, he would have stayed awake and would not have allowed anyone to break through the wall of his house. Therefore, you too must stand ready because the Son of Man is coming at an hour you do not expect.'
